<u>Membership</u>

Our membership is increasing and the club is looking very healthy. A number of people have taken advantage of our family membership, where we are pleased to welcome a number of sons and daughters.

So don't be afraid to recommend our club to others, we are currently looking at some new venues and negotiating access, so we will be wanting as many competitors and volunteers as we can get to make our club hum again.

The different membership options we offer, apart from ordinary membership are.
