7. ENTRIES

These open with the publication of these regulations and close at 9.00am on Sunday **8 November 2020**

To be valid, Entries are to be made on the correct form, be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fee. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry at their discretion, and as prescribed in the National Sporting Code and these regulations. Acceptance of entry will be notified by email as provided on the entry form.

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS WILL BE LIMITED TO 25 The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 20 entries are received a week prior to the event.

COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS: in signing the entry form participants are deemed to fully comply with the event organisers directives. This is also a declaration that the vehicle they are competing in is up to all warrant of fitness standards.

8. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

All cars shall comply with Schedule C of the current Motorsport NZ Manual. Cars will be inspected.

All drivers must produce the following at Documentation:

- Crash Helmet and Overalls (or clean cotton work overalls) that are to be used on the day.

NO PASSENGERS will be carried by participants on the track except during driver training with instructors.

9. SAFETY PROVIDED BY EVENT ORGANISERS

- 4 Flag Marshall Points Around the 1.5 km circuit
- Fire extinguishers at each flag marshal point
- First Aid person on site

10. DRIVER TRAINING PROGRAMME:

- Initial safety briefing 9:00am
- Tuition of the race line & safety flags
- Braking
- Collision avoidance (braking hard and turning)
- Cornering through cones
- Tuition on race line with instructors
- Lunch Break 12:30pm
- Track time to practice your technique
- Reverse of the track rotation with all marker cones removed
- Single car sprints until 4:30 (timed laps)
- 4:30pm – Event conclusion and debrief

11. NOISE

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that their vehicle is adequately muffled to an acceptable level Max noise level permitted by Manfeild is 80dBA. Any vehicle deemed to exceed acceptable noise levels may be excluded from competing by the CotC.

12. DAMAGE

Participants will not hold the organisers for this event, Wellington Car Club or Manfeild operators liable for any damage they may cause to public or private property or own vehicles
